### **Bell Street Park - More than 160 People Attend Design Meeting!**

Last Wednesday, January 13, 2010, 7pm - 9pm

This meeting was sponsored by the Belltown Community Council and Seattle Parks & Recreation Department with more than 160 people meeting at the Olympic Sculpture Park.

This was the second of three public meetings for community participation in the design of the Bell Street Park (On Bell Street between 1st & 5th Avenues). Two very different designs were presented by the urban architect team of SVR & Hewitt. In addition, a study was discussed on the levels of light presently found on Bell Street. Not to anyone's surprise, the light along this street is woefully inadequate and almost non-existent in some areas. The new Park design will correct this issue.

There was great discussion about the two designs and a series of votes were held to better understand those design components the community envisioned as necessary. As a result of this effort we could see how the two very opposite

designs began to blend. From this effort we will see a final draft design for review in March 2010. The exact date of the final meeting will be determined around mid February.
