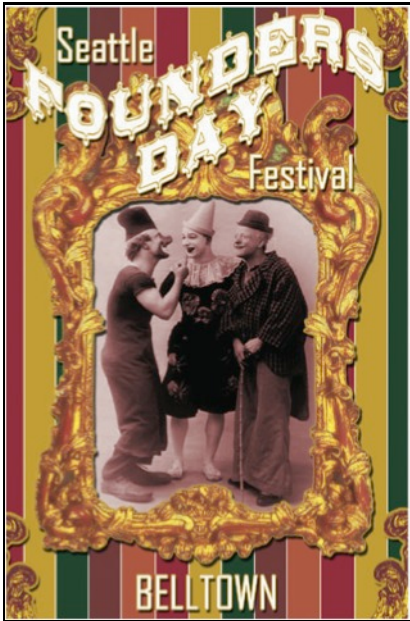

The Belltown Community Council applied for an "Opportunity Fund" Grant of \$650,000 to correct design issues and to allow Regrade Park to benefit from the new Bell Street Park design. Lighting improvements, connectivity to the new bioswale, new ADA access, a redesigned Bell Street side fence, and new art pieces are some of the improvements to be made.
